Dual Enrollment Participation Agreement

What is Dual Enrollment? Dual Enrollment provides students with the opportunity to get a head start on their college program while earning high school credit at the same time. Students in grades 9-12 who qualify are eligible to participate. Students may enroll on a part-time or full-time basis as a Dual Enrollment student and take college courses. Students will receive high school and college credit simultaneously when attending and passing approved college classes. The State of Georgia covers all costs (tuition, books, and fees).

Guidelines:

- Applicants must apply to their college of choice. (Watch for deadlines!)
- Applicants must submit all supplementary documents (transcript, birth certificate, etc.).
- Applicant will receive admissions acceptance letter from the college.
- Applicant will meet with the college's dual enrollment coordinator/counselor.
- Applicant must complete the MOWR application on gafutures.org.
- Once courses are scheduled, student must bring their schedule to their high school counselor.
- Students are required to take at least 4 courses each semester and can include a combination of traditional school courses offered at Loganville High School and MOWR courses.
- Students wishing to withdraw from a MOWR course must do so within the **first ten days of the semester**.
- NOTE: Students who withdraw from a course **MUST** enroll in another MOWR course or enroll in a course offered at LHS. All students **MUST** have at least 4 courses each semester.
- **Students who withdraw from a MOWR course after the first 10 days of the semester will receive an F on their high school transcript (even if the college allows them to drop without a failing grade).**
- Students who fail a MOWR course may be removed from the program and may not be allowed to enroll in another MOWR course.
- Students will not be allowed to take an online college course on LHS campus.

Awarding Credit:

- All MOWR courses will be posted to the student's Loganville High School transcript.
- MOWR courses will be weighted according to the Walton County School District policy. Students receive 10 additional points for each MOWR course.
