Grant Goals and Objectives**



**Goal 1 – Increase academic performance through engaging academic activities**

1. Objective 1.1. 55% of regularly attending students (those attending 30 days or more) Georgia Milestone EOGT/EOCT eligible students will meet or exceed state standards on Georgia Milestones – Math
2. Objective 1.2. 55% of regularly attending students (those attending 30 days or more) Georgia Milestone EOGT/EOCT eligible students will meet or exceed state standards on Georgia Milestones – ELA
3. Objective 1.3. 55% of regularly attending students (those attending 30 days or more) will increase or maintain their numeric classroom grades from fall to spring – Math
4. Objective 1.4. 55% of regularly attending students (those attending 30 days or more) will increase or maintain their numeric classroom grades from fall to spring – ELA

**Goal 2 - Improve positive student behavior and youth development through personal enrichment - cultural experiences, recreational activities, the arts, life skills education, health education, technology – in a positive and safe environment that empowers students to grow socially, emotionally and academically**

1. Objective 1.1. 75% of regularly attending students (those attending 30 days or more) will improve their homework completion
2. Objective 2.2. 60% of regularly attending students (those attending 30 days or more) in need of improving classroom participation will increase their level of classroom participation

**Goal 3 – Increase family engagement and student success through adult literacy education and family focused events**

1. Objective 3.1. 50% of parents/caregivers of regularly attending students (those attending 30 days or more) will report that they have learned ways to help their child be more successful in school
2. Objective 3.2. 45% of parents/caregivers of regularly attending students (those attending 30 days or more) will attend at least two parent nights
