

LMS STRIKE SYSTEM

3 STRIKES = Teacher assigned detention (mandatory parent contact by teacher)

6 STRIKES = Teacher assigned detention (mandatory parent contact by teacher)

7 STRIKE = Referral to administration with documentation included on referral. (Mandatory parent contact by teacher)

8th STRIKE AND BEYOND = REFERRAL EACH STRIKE AFTER

*Mandatory contact can include email, phone conversation, or personal meeting

STRIKES DO NOT INCLUDE TARDIES!!

STRIKES CAN INCLUDE AND ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Behavior issues (Make sure you are following IEP, 504, POI, BIP instructions)
- Gum/ candy / eating
- Disobeying the class rules
- Being chronically unprepared for class (Teacher investigates why?)
- Class disruption- interrupting instruction
- Disregarding teacher's instructions
- Running
- Can include some level one offenses (at the Teacher's discretion)

Teachers will keep detailed notes on strikes referring to why strikes were given. This will include date, time and parent contact on the 3rd, 6th and 7th strike (and beyond). They will use the strike system as a progressive plan to avoid referrals. Referrals are a part of a student's educational/ behavioral record. Teams will be consistent and relay their expectations in the class to their students.

ALL STRIKES WILL reset at the beginning of each 8 week period. This means the student gets a balance of 0 every quarter.

Strikes are issued by TEACHER NOT by TEAM. Teachers may not combine your strikes.

STRIKES BEGIN THE first day of school and the first day of each quarter (noted on the county website calendar)

LMS TARDY SYSTEM

3 TARDIES = Teacher assigned detention (mandatory parent contact by teacher)

6 TARDIES = Teacher assigned detention (mandatory parent contact by teacher)

7 TARDIES = Referral to administration with documentation included on referral. (mandatory parent contact by teacher)

8th TARDIES AND BEYOND = REFERRAL EACH TARDY there AFTER

*Mandatory contact can include email, phone conversation, or personal meeting

Tardies are to be recorded by Teacher by period.

LMS DETENTION GUIDELINES FOR TEACHERS

DETENTION TIMES: 2:45-3:15 OR you can be flexible, several silent lunch detentions (Teacher led) and do detention 6:45-7:12 a.m.

TEACHERS NEED TO VERIFY PICKUP TIME AT 3:15 ON THE FRONT PORCH.

TEACHERS NEED TO ESCORT THEIR STUDENTS TO THE FRONT PORCH at detention dismissal at 3:15.

Teachers also need to notify parents of what room the detention is held in and who is the responsible party for their child (your name) at the time/ date of the detention.

If students do not serve the entire 30 minutes, they will serve another detention.

If students are tardy to detention, they will serve another detention.
