Meals are priced to cover the cost of food, supplies/overhead, and labor involved to produce the meal. Student meals are subsidized slightly by the federal government based on the student's status.

Students must pick up what is considered a "reimbursable" meal for the meal charge to be applied. "Reimbursable" means they have at least ½ cup fruit/vegetable plus two other food groups at lunch, or two additional items at breakfast. Reduced and free benefits apply at both breakfast and lunch. Extras, partial, and second meals must always be paid with cash in hand or on account, reduced and free benefits do not apply for extras, partial, or second meals.
